Raja Rammohun Roy Mahavidyalaya is a multi-disciplinary college, situated at Radhanagar, the birth place of Raja Rammohun Roy, the harbinger of Indian Renaissance. It is a rural area of Hooghly District in West Bengal with borders of each of Howrah, East Medinipur and West Medinipur Districts within 10km areal distance. It was founded in 1964 on the International Mother Language Day, 21 February at the initiative of local people and it got affiliation from the University of Burdwan within a short period in the same year. In 1965, it was conferred with approval of the University Grants Commission under section 2f. In 1972, Mrs. Indira Gandhi, the then Prime Minister of India, visited the college on the occasion of bi-centenary birth celebration of Raja Rammohun Roy. Within a short time after her visit, the college was accorded Government Sponsored Status from the State Government.
